Putney, Vermont - IGG Software, LLC announces the release of iBiz 3, a new version of its popular time-billing and invoicing application for Mac OS X 10.4 (www.iggsoftware.com/ibiz). In addition to improved reporting and invoicing, new features include iCal synchronization, Applescript support, automatic document tracking, quick timers and a new billing section. iBiz 3 is a universal binary, running natively on both PowerPC and Intel macs.

"We've taken customers' feedback and used it to create a greatly enhanced user workflow and interface", says president and founder of IGG Software Ian Gillespie. "iBiz 3 is more powerful but also more intuitive, which we feel is very important for Mac OS X software".

Many of the new features of iBiz center around minimizing interruptions in user workflow. The new Document Monitor feature automatically keeps track of time spent working on specific files that have been associated with iBiz. This allows users to simply open the files they want to work on and iBiz will automatically start tracking the time. Close the file, and iBiz stops the timer.

iCal synchronization uses Sync Services to automatically sync entire iBiz projects with iCal calendars. Quick Timer is a new feature of iBiz 3 which allows users to start, stop and manage timers quickly, without interrupting their workflow.

Returning users of iBiz will find the new Billing section offers a more powerful overview of invoices, estimates and payments for a client. "The Billing section is designed to give users a 'big-picture' view of a client's status, something that users have requested frequently", says Gillespie.

"We've also expanded the functionality of the server version of iBiz 3", says Gillespie. "iBiz Server 3 now has support for managing group rates, complete control over user permissions and support for remote connections over TCP/IP".

iBiz 3 is priced at \$49.99 (\$19.99 for upgrading users of iBiz 2). iBiz Server 3 is priced at \$89.99 and includes two free client codes; the upgrade price for iBiz Server 3 is \$39.99.
